

THE RESORT AT PELICAN HILL - 5*


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THE LODGE AT TORREY PINES -5*




PELICAN HILL SOUTH





PGA WEST STADIUM COURSE


A Pete Dye golf course, Stadium delivers multiple adrenaline rushes throughout the round. The stadium is the annual Host course to the PGA TOUR's CareerBuilder Challenge, formerly known as the Bob Hope Classic, and the PGA TOUR "Q-School" Finals every other year. Golfers must navigate the island green of hole #17, known as Alcatraz, as well as the menacing water-lined 18th as they end their golfing journey. Imagine needing to make par-par on two of the toughest finishing holes in golf to win a PGA TOUR tournament or to earn the coveted PGA TOUR card! Named "Stadium" thanks to Dye's ingenious plan to




sculpt spectator seating into the natural terrain, many historic moments in golf have occurred here, including Lee Trevino's unforgettable hole-in-one on Alcatraz. This won him a carry-over Skin worth \$175,000 in the 1987 made-for-TV "Skins Game," hosted at PGA WEST from 1986-1991. With five sets of tees, the Stadium lures all skill levels.









AVIARA GOLF CLUB

Named the #1 golf resort in Southern California according to the readers of Condé Nast Traveler. Also, named one of the best resort golf courses in the country by Golf Digest and Golf Magazine, Aviara Golf Club is San Diego's only golf course designed by Arnold Palmer. Aviara Golf Club features a memorable coastal layout: par 72, 18 holes over 7,007 yards uniquely sculpted around rolling hillsides, plenty of bunkers, water features, and landscaped with native wildflowers of Southern California. Located within an elegant two-story, 32,000 square-foot Spanish colonial clubhouse are premier player amenities, such as lockers, showers, lounge area, full-service bar, and Argyle Steakhouse – a fine dining restaurant with outdoor balcony seating available. Professional golf facilities at Aviara include a driving range, putting green, state-of-the-art GPS systems on all golf carts, and an upscale golf pro shop.








TORREY PINES SOUTH COURSE

Designed by William Bell, Sr. in 1957. Both Torrey Pines North & South courses are home of the Farmers Insurance Open PGA Golf Tournament played in the first week of February. Both 18-hole courses (North and South courses are very scenic with beautiful ocean views). Torrey Pines signature hole is located on the North course on hole #6. The South course is the more challenging of the two and hosts the final round of the Farmer's Insurance Open as well as the 2008 & 2021 U.S. Open Championship Tournaments.





THE MOUNTAIN COURSE

The Mountain Course, nestled at the base of the picturesque Santa Rosa Mountains, is famed for its Pete Dye design, playability, and stunning visuals. This ultra-challenging course features pot bunkers, rock formations, elevations of tee boxes, and well-bunkered greens. Perhaps there is a Zen moment for golfers who experience this course, a pairing of nature and manmade artistry. Pete Dye was no doubt inspired as he set out to create the course. Famous for its design, stunning visual drama, and signature 16th hole, the Mountain Course is ranked among Golf Magazine's "Top 100 Courses You Can Play."
