Golfer to Golfer offers you a 7-night, 5-course golf vacation in Arizona's Scottsdale, the golf capital of the American West.



These luxurious rooms feature warm desert accents and contemporary Southwestern






GRAYHAWK GOLF CLUB - RAPTOR COURSE

The Raptor Course, designed by Tom Fazio, offers thrilling challenges that command players' respect through a high-stakes game of risk and reward. Spanning 7,151 yards from the back tees, the par-72 course unfolds over the gentle hills and through the shady natural arroyos found in this picturesque corner of the Sonoran Desert. Most of Raptor's fairways are generous and the greens are wide and undulating. Misses tend to find deep greenside bunkers and grass collection areas, making the scramble to get up and down a true test of the short game.













QUINTERO GOLF CLUB

A master course designer, Rees Jones has carved a magnificent course out of a pristine section of the lush Arizona desert. Quintero is a "must-play" course for any committed player, offering challenges in strategic bunker placement, with generous landing areas for those straight hitters. Rees Jones' design is strategic and challenging and was crafted with respect for the natural beauty of the surrounding desert landscape. From the tips, this top Arizona golf course will challenge even the scratch golfers among us with demanding shots from tee to green. 


TPC SCOTTSDALE - STADIUM COURSE

As the PGA TOUR stop with the largest crowds of any golf event in the world, The Waste Management Phoenix Open brings immeasurable attention and respect to the Stadium Course, designed by the team of Tom Weiskopf and Jay Morrish. The course, which was renovated in 2014, is most famous for its par-3, 16th hole that transforms into "The



Coliseum" during the tournaments and provides fans with one of the most exciting settings in professional sports.










WE-KO-PA CHOLLA GOLF COURSE

The Cholla Course at We-Ko-Pa Golf Club offers a dramatic test of golf that plays through shady arroyos, over desert ridges and amid some of the most picturesque Sonoran Desert on the planet. For this reason, Cholla is widely considered as one of the most pristine desert golf experiences in the Southwest with no homes or other development to spoil the sweeping views of the nearby river valleys, Red Mountain, Four Peaks and the rest of the majestic Superstition Mountains. The aesthetic charm of Cholla appeals to golfers just as much as its strategic challenge.







TROON NORTH - MONUMENT COURSE

Troon North Golf Club stands as a hallmark of the Scottsdale desert golf experience with two 18-hole courses stretching through the natural ravines and foothills in the shadows of Pinnacle Peak. Giant granite boulders lie strewn across the rugged landscape of



Arizona's Sonoran Desert, where Troon North Golf Club combines iconic golf with the visual sensation of desert landscape, providing a standard unmatched in the American Southwest.






